



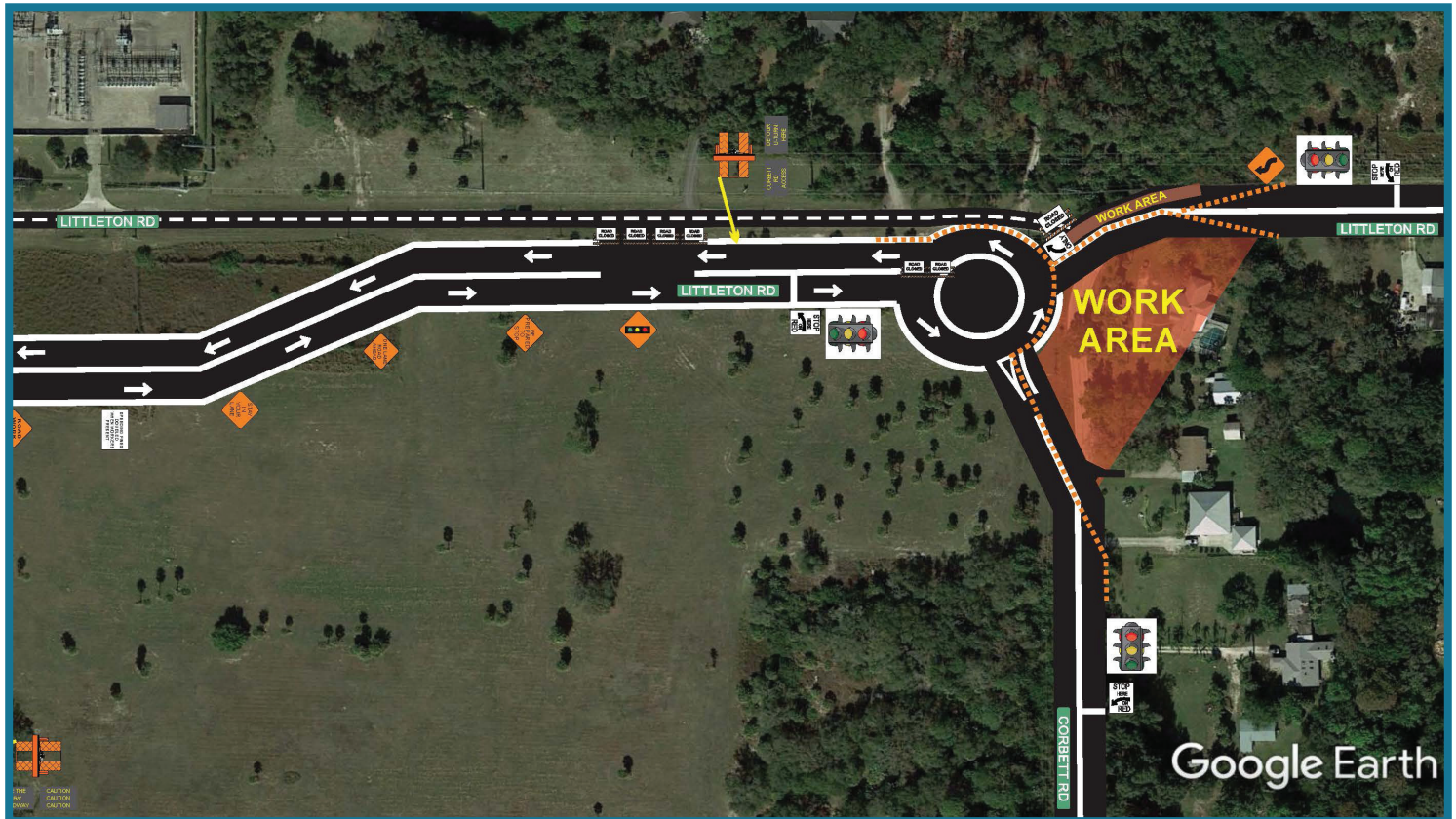
Littleton Road/Kismet Parkway Realignment Project

From NE 24th Avenue to Corbett Road

Construction Update July 2, 2020

Beginning the week of July 9, the contractor for the Littleton Road-Kismet Parkway Realignment Project will begin paving the newly constructed roadway from NE 24th Avenue/Kismet Parkway to Corbett Road. This includes paving the new roundabout. Once paving is completed, crews will be installing signs and temporary signals.

Motorists should expect the roundabout to partially open in mid-July. During this phase, the roundabout will first open with limited movement. Temporary signals will be installed at the roundabout entrances on eastbound Littleton Road, westbound Littleton Road, and northbound Corbett Road to control when vehicles enter the roundabout. The traffic lights will allow one movement at a time. To travel westbound Littleton Road to southbound Corbett Road, motorists will continue west on Littleton Road through the roundabout and make a U-turn to return to Corbett Road. This will only be necessary during this phase of work. By restricting the number of vehicles in the roundabout, the contractor is able to work next to traffic to complete the roundabout construction, while keeping the road open to vehicles. The work area will shift as construction progresses.
